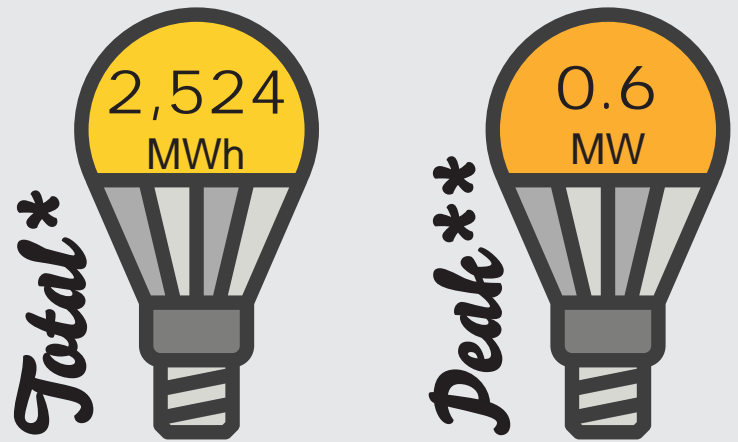
To assist with up-front costs of upgrades, EWEB offers rebates and zero-interest loans.

**Saving energy during peak hours, when demand is highest, is important because peak power is more expensive & can have higher greenhouse gas emissions.

The energy savings is roughly equivalent to taking 113 passenger vehicles off the road, or the carbon sequestered by 700 acres of forest.

Some Rental projects are also Income-qualifying. The most popular upgrades were ductless heat pumps, followed by windows and insulation.
