



Neighbor Survey Results

In April 2020, EWEB conducted a survey of neighbors who live adjacent to the E. 40th water storage site. The goal was to collect input about landscaping, walking paths and other features that honor the special nature of the 10-acre open space and ridge line. Approximately 40 households were invited to participate in the online survey, which was administered in place of a community meeting due to COVID-19 social distancing requirements.

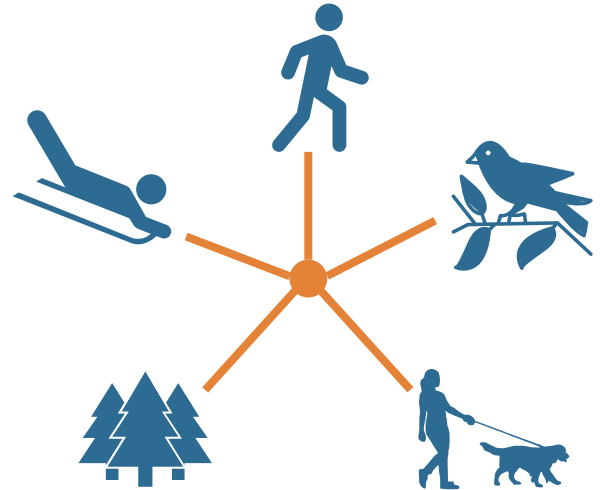
